Name of Scholarship CCU Scholarships for international students Qualifications 1. First-year international students Undergraduate students should complete at least 8 credit hours with an average course grade of over 65 in the previous 2. semester. Ph.D. and postgraduate students should complete at least 4 credit hours with an average course grade of over 75 in the previous 3. semester. 4. Students who do not have an average course grade of the previous semester, and is currently in the process of writing thesis for the Ph.D. or Master program, have to provide recommendation letters from their advisors, along with a list of their research accomplishments (including thesis proposals and published papers). Students must have good conduct and no rule violation record. 5. **Application period** First-year international students shall apply at admission 1. On-campus students: Those who have studied at CCU for more than one semester must apply by April 15th and November 15th 2. of each year. Application First-year international students: Apply along with admission application procedure On-campus students: 1. Apply to the Division of International Students of Office of International Affairs for the scholarship of next semester. Application materials: 2. Transcripts of the previous semester Α. Scholarships for Prime Full-time International Doctoral Students of National Chung Cheng University

Qualifications	International students who are admitted in or after the academic year of 2019, as full time Ph.D. students via the Ph.D. selection screening, written examination, application, or direct pursuit of Ph.D. degree, with academic records and research potentials are qualified to apply for this scholarship.
Application period	 At admission At the beginning of Fall/Spring semester, depending on the announcement from the CCU Office of International Affairs
Application procedure	The University offers a quota of maximum 30 awardees in each academic year. Applications have to be submitted by the student, initially approved by the department and finally grated by the college. The final list of granted scholarships will be sent to the Office of Research and Development for budget control, and finally executed by the Office of International Affairs.
Content of the Scholarship	 LEVEL A: NT\$40,000 per month. LEVEL B: NT\$30,000 per month. LEVEL C: NT\$20,000 per month. An application by a freshman student will only considered for LEVEL C scholarship, and the scholarship will be awarded on a monthly basis. Starting from the second year, the scholarship for each month will be adjusted based on the student's research results and performance. *Notice: Full-time international Ph.D. students, during the period of being granted this scholarship, should publish their research results in international journals indexed by the WOS or Scopus, and the publications should bear the name of the University. Students with any one of the following circumstances are not qualified to apply for the scholarship. Have full-time job in a public or private organization. In the academic year of admission, the applicant student opted for suspension of studies, reserving the admission status, or did not finish registration procedures. The scholarship awarded students can also obtain the following award items: Partial or total exemption of tuition and credit fees. Partial or total exemption of miscellaneous fees Exemption from on-campus accommodation fees (the amount of exempted is by the minimum dormitory fees of each academic year). Those who have withdrawn from the dormitory voluntarily, shall not be compensated by any amount. Living stipend (by the annual budgets)

Scholarship	sub-fields) on average within five years calculated by JCR, each article will be awarded 1 unit.
	2. Excellent journal papers: published in SCI or SSCI journals and ranked in the top (including) 50% in their field (including sub-
	fields) on average within five years calculated by JCR, and each article will be awarded 0.5 units. Journals in various fields not
	ranked in the top 50% can be regarded as excellent journals and included in the awarded scope through the review of the
	committee of the Institute of Computer Science and Information Engineering.
	*The amount of each reward unit converted into the reward money is the total subsidy amount divided by the total reward unit,

The Review Committee of the AIM-HI Scholarship will evaluate the incoming international students' application documents 3. before awarding any AIM-HI Scholarships to the faculty mentor.
